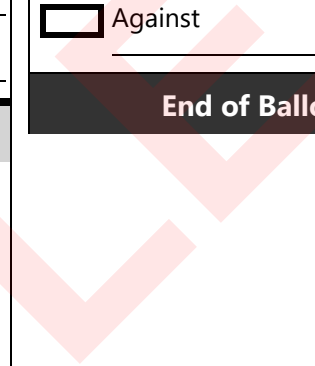
Macon County Local Sales and Use Tax
